

Responsibilities and Duties:

Clinical Interventions

- Provide individual, couple, family, and group therapy.
- Develop treatment plans specific to the client's needs.
- Conduct risk assessments and helps clients develop safety plans when needed.
- Adapt treatment methods according to the cultural needs of the client.
- Participate in collaborative treatment with practice clinicians and external organizations to coordinate client care.
- Maintain appropriate professional boundaries.
- Adhere to the ethical standards set by the American Counseling Association (ACA).

Client Information System

- Maintain all required client documentation in the Electronic Health Record (EHR) system.
- Maintain an awareness of applicable laws, regulations, and licensing requirements as they relate to client documentation.
- Responsible for providing appropriate documentation of all therapy/counseling sessions, significant collateral contacts, and phone conversations, etc. consistent with applicable regulatory requirements.
- Assure all needed releases of information and other paperwork are present in the file and up to date. Promptly requests new or additional information and paperwork as needed.
- Complete required documentation to ensure timely billing for services provided.

Team/Supervision Meetings

- Participate in bi-monthly clinical team and case staffing meetings with clinical supervisor.
- Participate in licensure hours supervision as required by your institution and the Board of Professional Counselors and Marriage and Family Therapists
- Participate in peer consultation as needed.
